**Fri, Apr-30 DEPART THE UNITED STATES** Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

**Sat, May -1 Warsaw** Welcome to Warsaw Poland! The Phoenix City and Paris of the North. Meet your Tour Director at the airport for one group transfer to your accommodations. Join your Tour Director and traveling companions this evening for a welcoming group orientation.

**Sun, May -2 WARSAW – GDANSK** Today's included sightseeing tour with a Local Guide is an excellent introduction to Warsaw. Magnificently reconstructed after WWII, Warsaw is a rich tapestry of nearly every European architectural style, from Gothic to Neoclassical, with wide, modern avenues in striking contrast to the narrow lanes of the old section. Continuing to Gdansk on the Baltic Sea, discover one of the most important Hanseatic cities in the 14th and 15th centuries. Dinner is included at a local restaurant. • (B,D)

**Mon, May -3 GDANSK** • Among the most important shipping ports in Northern Europe, Gdansk (formerly known by its German name, Danzig) is the birthplace of "Solidarity," the Polish trade union that revolutionized Polish modern politics. This morning, your Local Guide takes you on an enlightening city tour revealing the city's past and present. • Enjoy free time to explore on your own for the balance of the day. • Dinner at your hotel this evening. • (B,D)

**Tue, May -4 GDANSK – TORUN – POZNAN** The first stop today is medieval Torun on the Vistula River, birthplace of renaissance astronomer Copernicus and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Your Local Guide will introduce you to the many captivating highlights, including the starówka (Old Town) with the ruins of a 13th-century Teutonic Knights' castle, as well as many samples of Gothic architecture. Head west to Poznan, one of the country's oldest cities and a part of Polish history for the past 1,000 years. This afternoon, discover the main attractions on your included city sightseeing tour with a Local Guide. • Dinner at a local eatery. (B,D)

**Wed, May -5 POZNAN – JASNA GORA – KRAKOW** The guided tour of Jasna Góra in Czestochowa unveils the story of the Monastery that withstood the repeated onslaughts of overwhelming Swedish forces during the religious wars of the 17th century. Since then, its Black Madonna has been venerated as the "Queen of Poland" and has become the country's national symbol. Continue to Kraków. No trip to Poland is complete without a little polka! This fun evening showcases the traditional 19th-century dance that originated in Bohemia. Join your Tour Director for an authentic dinner of Polish specialties with wine, coffee, and lively polka music and dancing. By the end of the night, you'll be up and polka-ing yourself! • (B,D)

**Thur, May -6 KRAKOW. EXCURSION TO THE WIELICZKA SALT MINE** Dating back to the 7th century, Kraków is revered by many as Poland's most beautiful city. It was the country's capital for over 500 years. On your included guided tour, see the Market Square, the Jewish Quarter, Wawel Hill, and visit the Cathedral. This afternoon, head into the salty underground world of the Wieliczka Salt Mine on this unique half-day excursion. A major producer of table salt from the 13th century until 2007, this UNESCO World Heritage Site is a surreal labyrinth of tunnels where everything has been carved from salt blocks! Join an expert guide and head down, down, down to a depth of 136 meters (446 feet) below the Earth's surface and into the mines. Wander past ornate monuments, a subterranean salt lake, and see the mine's biggest claim to fame: the incredible Chapel of St. Kinga, made entirely of salt—from its chandelier to its altarpiece! • (B)

**Fri, May -7 KRAKOW. EXCURSION TO ZAKOPANE** Get a breath of fresh mountain air today on the included excursion to Zakopane. Located in a picturesque valley at the base of the Tatra Mountain range, Zakopane has developed into a beautiful, pristine resort. Typical of this area are the highland wooden houses, cafes, restaurants, and the local shops on Krupowki Street. Enjoy a little hiking or browse around the small market for authentic souvenirs. Return to Krakow for dinner at your hotel and overnight. (B,D)

**Sat, May -8 KRAKOW – AUSCHWITZ – WARSAW** Encounter sobering history this morning on your visit to the Auschwitz concentration camp, a chilling reminder of the Holocaust. In the afternoon, continue to Warsaw. Balance of the day is at your leisure. • (B)

**Sun, May -9 DEPART WARSAW** After breakfast, one group transfer is organized to the Warsaw Airport. • (B)
