Sun, Oct-3 DUBLIN ARRIVAL POWERSCOURT, BROWNSHILL DOLMEN, DUCKETT'S GROVE After landing at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Visit Powerscourt House, the former home of Lord Powerscourt. Then experience the delightful terraced Italian gardens and abundant floral displays. Also view the superb collection of trees, shrubs and flowers gathered from all around the world. Visit the Brownshill Dolmen, a massive prehistoric portal tomb located near Carlow Town, famous for having the largest capstone in Europe. Constructed between 4,900 and 5,500 years ago during the Neolithic period, this megalithic structure consists of a giant granite capstone resting on two upright portal stones and was designed for ritualistic purposes or as a burial place for elite members of Neolithic society. Today, it stands as one of Ireland's most awe-inspiring prehistoric monuments. Visit Duckett's Grove, a stunning, ruined 19th-century Gothic Revival mansion and former home of the Duckett Family. After a fire, the surviving towers and turrets of Duckett's Grove become one of the most photographed locations in the country. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: MOUNT WOLSELEY HOTEL, TULLOW

Mon, Oct-4 DELTA SENSORY GARDEN, THE CHOCOLATE GARDEN OF IRELAND, HUNTINGTON CASTLE & GARDENS Visit Delta Sensory Gardens, renowned as an award-winning, 2.5-acre "oasis of peace", designed to stimulate all five senses through 16 interconnecting themed areas. Visit The Chocolate Garden of Ireland, an award-winning family-run business, established in 2001 that produces a wonderful range of handcrafted chocolates, premium ice cream and delectable treats. The site offers interactive chocolate-making workshops, a café, gift shop and a playground. Here, enjoy a talk and tasting with your group. Journey to Huntington Castle, a historic Irish estate built in 1625 by Sir Laurence Esmonde. Enjoy a guided tour to discover the architecture and historical objects in the family estate and stroll through the delightful 17th-century gardens. The castle has been occupied by descendants of the original family for over 400 years. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: ORMONDE HOTEL, KILKENNY

Tue, Oct-5 KILKENNY WALKING TOUR AND KILKENNY CASTLE Embark on a guided walking tour of Kilkenny. The humorous and informative guide will show you many sites, which help make stories about the past come to life. Visit Kilkenny Castle, which stands high over Kilkenny City, overlooking the River Nore. The original Anglo-Norman stone castle was built for the 4th Earl of Pembroke, and it later became the residence for the Butler family and Earl of Ormond. The castle estate also boasts both formal and informal gardens. OVERNIGHT: ORMONDE HOTEL, KILKENNY

Wed, Oct-6 IRISH NATIONAL HERITAGE PARK AND HOOK LIGHTHOUSE Visit the Irish National Heritage Park, an open-air museum renowned for recreating 9,000 years of Irish history across 35–40 acres. The site is particularly known for its authentic, to-scale reconstructions of dwellings, burial sites, and holy places from prehistoric to Norman times. The area also includes a reconstructed Viking shipyard and harbour, alongside the original remains of the first Anglo-Norman fortification in Ireland. Explore the oldest operational lighthouse in the world. Built 800 years ago by Knight William Marshal, take a step back in time and hear tales of medieval times and life as a light keeper. Take in the spectacular view from the balcony with miles of sea rolling out before you. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: TALBOT HOTEL, WEXFORD

Thu, Oct-7 JOHNSTOWN CASTLE GARDENS AND KILMORE FREE TIME Visit the Johnstown Castle Estate & Gardens to view the fairytale gothic-revival Irish castle designed by Daniel Robertson and visit its gorgeous 120-acre estate with formal gardens, featuring lakeside walks and a 4-acre walled garden. Travel to Kilmore for some free time to sightsee around the quintessential Irish fishing village on your own. The scenic coastal destination is famous for its traditional whitewashed thatched cottages and bustling seafood industry as well as being home to the Saltee Islands, one of Ireland's largest bird sanctuaries. OVERNIGHT: TALBOT HOTEL, WEXFORD

Fri, Oct-8 JFK HOMESTEAD AND DUNBRODY EMIGRANT SHIP Stop at the JFK Homestead, birthplace of President John F. Kennedy's great-grandfather. Today, it is still farmed by John's descendants and celebrates the story of the Kennedy dynasty. Visit Dunbrody Emigrant Ship, a replica of a sailing vessel built in 1845 to transport emigrants from Ireland to North America. The visit will give you an insight as to what life on board ship was like as well as filling you in on the history of the famine years. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: TRIDENT HOTEL, KINSALE

Sat, Oct-9 LUSITANIA MUSEUM & SIGNAL TOWER, KINSALE HARBOUR CRUISE AND KINSALE FOOD TOUR Visit the Lusitania Museum and learn about the the story of the RMS Lusitania, which was torpedoed during WW1 by a German U-boat on May 7th 1915 resulting in immense loss. Also see the Old Head Signal Tower, just over 200 years old. It was built during the Napoleonic wars in response to the threat of a French invasion. There were 81 such towers with line-of-sight visibility from one to the next. Embark on a cruise along Kinsale Harbour, which is not only rich with historical sites but also offers breathing views. While on board, learn about the town of Kinsale and see views of the Old Head of Kinsale. Set off on a guided walking food tour to explore the captivating history of Kinsale's culinary rise to mastery. Along the way, try many tantalizing treats as you leisurely walk through the harbor town on an adventure that is sure to please even an avid foodie. OVERNIGHT: TRIDENT HOTEL, KINSALE

Sun, Oct-10 KINSALE TO ENNIS RINGFINNAN GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE Visit the Ringfinnan Garden of Remembrance, a living memorial dedicated to the 343 FDNY firefighters and chaplain Father Mychal Judge who died in the 9/11 attacks. Established in 2002 by Kathleen Murphy, an Irish nurse who worked in New York for over 30 years and knew many of the firefighters. The 1-acre site features 343 trees, each bearing a firefighter's name, along with a special tree for Chaplain Father Mychal Judge. The site offers a quiet, reflective space that honors the Irish-American link. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: TEMPLE GATE HOTEL, ENNIS

Mon, Oct-11 RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES All too soon, your vacation in Ireland has come to an end. Transfer to Shannon Airport in plenty of time to check in for your flight.
